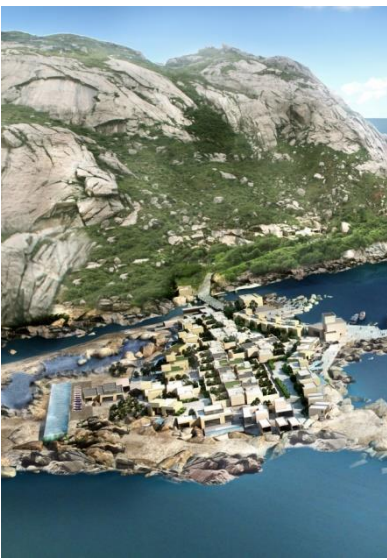

Description: An exclusive Four Seasons Resort located just off the northeast coast of Phuket, in an island called Naka Yai. The Resort covers total site area of 220,000 m2 with 18,000 m2 gross floor area for the buildings, and consists of 100 villas, Resorts Centre, Multi-Function Pavillion, Specialty Restaurant and Bar, Spa Village, Beach Hub and Kids Club, Water Sports Centre and Back of House buildings.

Description: This bar’s distinctive shape recalls the whale shark, elevated by light oak interiors and a softly lit neutral palette.
